...A LOOK BACK AT THE RECORD BREAKING WEEK LONG STORM ACROSS SOUTHWESTERN CALIFORNIA...

A LARGE UPPER LEVEL LOW PRESSURE SYSTEM TOOK RESIDENCE IN THE NORTHEASTERN PACIFIC LATE LAST WEEK. THE CIRCULATION AROUND THE SOUTHERN PERIPHERY OF THIS LOW PUMPED VERY MOIST AIR WITH A SUBTROPICAL CONNECTION INTO THE REGION. THIS ATMOSPHERIC RIVER OF MOISTURE REMAINED FOCUSED ACROSS SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA FROM LAST FRIDAY THE 17TH THROUGH YESTERDAY THE 22ND...BRINGING ALMOST CONTINUOUS RAIN TO THE REGION DURING THAT TIME. SEVERAL IMPULSES MOVING THROUGH THE MOIST FLOW CAUSED PERIODS OF HEAVY RAIN AT TIMES. FINALLY...LATE ON TUESDAY...THE UPPER LOW BEGAN TO SHIFT EASTWARD AND ITS STRONG FRONTAL SYSTEM MOVED THROUGH THE REGION TUESDAY NIGHT AND WEDNESDAY...BRINGING VERY HEAVY RAIN AND SCATTERED THUNDERSTORMS...AND PUTTING AN EXCLAMATION POINT ON WHAT WAS A VERY WET WEEK. THE RAIN SET MANY DAILY RECORDS ACROSS THE REGION...AND HAS MADE THIS ONE OF THE WETTEST DECEMBERS IN RECORDED HISTORY ACROSS MUCH OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA. UNFORTUNATELY...IT ALSO BROUGHT PERIODS OF FLOODING TO THE REGION...ALONG WITH SOME MUD AND DEBRIS FLOWS AND ROCK SLIDES...THE MOST SERIOUS OF WHICH OCCURRED ON WEDNESDAY.
